Calling Notice to the General Church Meeting and Timeline for the Nomination and election of Lay Leadership team at Waltham Chase Methodist Church (WCMC).

The General Church Meeting (GCM) /Church Council Meeting (CC) will be held on Wednesday 18th June 2025 at 7pm. The meeting is open to all church Members and regular worshippers, although voting at the GCM is for Church Members alone and voting on any elements that require CC approval will only be voted on by members of CC. At the meeting we will have the annual elections for Lay Leaders. This is the group of leaders who, in partnership with our Minister Revd. Phil Griffin, have the role of providing the spiritual leadership of Waltham Chase Methodist Church. Anyone who is a member at Waltham Chase Methodist Church is able to vote in this election.

People are elected to the role of Lay Leader for one year, where there are six Lay Leader positions. Five of the current Lay Leaders are seeking re-election, these are: Sam Charles, Julie Chester, Niki Freemantle, Julie Tizzard and Mark Tizzard. This means that there is <u>one</u> vacancy however any nominated church member is entitled to stand if they wish to test a call from God to lead in this particular way.

It is time to pray for insight about who God maybe calling to be on the Lay Leadership team at this time. Please remind yourself about the biblical 'person specification' for church leaders in 1 Tim Ch3: 1-13 and Titus Ch1: 6-9, and also the advice in 1 Peter Ch 5: 1-4.

Nominees must be full Methodist members of Waltham Chase Methodist Church.

How to nominate someone

- Nominations must be made by a (separate) full Methodist member of WCMC and seconded by another (separate) full Methodist member of WCMC
- Nominations should be made, via email, by midnight on Saturday 7th June 2025 to Rev Phil Griffin (rev_phil@outlook.com). If you have no access to the internet / email please ask one of the lay leaders to send your nomination on your behalf.
- Nominees will be announced to the church during the morning service on 8th
 June 2025 by the Lay Leader on duty.
- Nominees are invited to provide a brief written statement, explaining why
 they are standing as a Lay Leader. They can display a single copy of their
 statement (no more than one side of A4 paper please) on the foyer
 noticeboard, from anytime immediately after the am service on Sunday 8th
 June until the election.
